

## 2011 Colorado Truck Driving Championships Company Information

The 2011 Colorado Truck Driving Championship will be held on Saturday, June 4th at the Adams County Fairgrounds (9755 Henderson Road, Brighton).

**Driver Applications** must be **completely (and legibly)** filled out – including past experience, miles driven, accident information, etc. Incomplete applications are not eligible for the Leo Wozniak Award, and may not be accepted for entry into the competition. Please remember to attach a current copy of the driver's MVR.

**Facts for Drivers books are in-stock and available for pick-up.** We will release the books prior to receiving applications, but please be judicious in your numbers. If you think you will have 10 drivers compete, don't pick up 15 books. Extra copies of the book, large print editions, or audio CDs are available at cost from CMCA.

Please try to spread your driver applications among the 9 classes of competition. We are trying very hard not to limit the number of drivers a company can enter into a single class. However, if we end up with one or two classes that are too large to accommodate, we will be forced to implement class limits next year.

**Volunteers Needed!** As with any large event, the Rodeo could not be held without the support and hard work of over 150 volunteers. These volunteers put in countless hours throughout the year to make sure the Rodeo is the best event possible. Many of these volunteers are the first to show up and the last to leave on the day of the event. We are trying to get more involvement from our competing companies, and are asking for your help in securing volunteers. Recognizing that many of the family and colleagues want to be on-site to watch and cheer on your drivers, we are asking for "short-term" volunteers. We have specific tasks that can be accomplished in short periods of time (registration, exam monitors, score runners, clean-up crews). These positions only require a couple of hours, but would be immensely helpful to our Rodeo committee and core of volunteers. Please call Patti to discuss volunteer opportunities, and help the day run smoothly.

### Company Tents / Canopies

1. Companies **MUST** call Patti at CMCA to order their tent prior to the event (**due date is May 20, 2011**). Late entries will be accommodated if possible.
2. CMCA will order all the tents through one company, and pass along the cost of spaces to each individual company. This will save money and confusion for everyone.
3. There will be a fee for tent space payable to CMCA. Spaces will be laid out in 20x 20 foot grids.
4. Companies are responsible for **FULL** cleanup of their site – including trash removal, chairs/tables, food stuffs, and any other items. The site must be free of all trash and debris. If the volunteer committee has to clean up your company area, you will be charged a fee, based on the time it takes to clean.
5. Location of the tents / canopies will be selected by lottery. Spaces will be drawn on May 24<sup>th</sup>. Late registrations will be accommodated after the lottery has been drawn. Spaces will be allocated beginning in the middle of the site, and working outward.

**Company Signage / Advertisement** is strictly prohibited on the Adams County Fairgrounds. However, we have arranged for you to be able to display a company banner. Please make sure any signs or banners do not advertise for any goods, services, or employment opportunities. If a sign / banner is deemed unacceptable by Adams County, you will be required to remove it, and pay any and all fines, if applicable.

**No glass containers** are allowed in the Fairgrounds. Violation penalties will be charged back to the company.

Tents will be **set up on Friday**, beginning at noon. Deliveries of chairs, tables, grills, etc. can be accommodated on Friday after 2pm. Everything must be torn down and picked up on Saturday evening. There will be on-site security provided Friday evening. Violations will be charged back to the company.

There is ample **parking available**. **DO NOT** park on the side of the road. Illegally parked cars will be towed.
