Oversize/Overweight Permits

*In addition to the following, non-divisible oversize/overweight permits are available.

Longer Vehicle Combination (LVC)

A Longer Vehicle Combination (LVC) (C.R.S. 42-4-505) shall not have more than three cargo units, fewer than six axles nor more than nine axles. The heaviest gross weight shall be hauled in the first semitrailer. LVCs must obtain a special permit and **may only travel on designated routes**. LVCs, except the "Truck with Trailer" combination, have no overall length limitation. Gross vehicle weight limit is 80,000 pounds unless an overweight permit is purchased. C.R.S. 42-4-510(11)



Overweight Divisible Load Permits

Overweight divisible load permits are available for the following vehicle configurations and maximum weights:

- Quad axle permits allow maximum of 110,000 pounds.
- Triple axle permits allow maximum of 97,000 pounds.
- Tandem axle permits allow maximum of 97,000 pounds.

The actual maximum gross weight allowed is determined by vehicle axle configuration and highway traveled. Axle weight limits are determined by Colorado Department of Transportation Bridge Weight Map.
